

Installation

Thank you for buying Mirrl. Our hard wearing material has been designed and manufactured to the highest standards and we hope you will have many years of pleasure using it.

To ensure the validity of our 10 year warranty, please ensure that it is fitted with due care in accordance with the guidance below.

Mirrl as a material is best thought of and treated as a laminate when machining and finishing. *

With sharp edged tooling breakout will be minimised.

To joint Mirrl pieces together standard worktop procedures should be observed.

Jointing compound with instructions can be provided by us to produce a chemically welded seamless joint.

Mirrl is typically finished by us with 320 grit sandpaper and surface finish product, such as Eagle Solid Surface Cleaner®.

Any subsequent work by you should finish at the same grit and with equivalent product to maintain surface appearance consistency.

*As such it is important to note that although Mirrl is a solid surface, any excessive sanding will cut through the layers and change the immediate appearance of the joint. It is advised to get a completely flush seam prior to chemical welding.
